The inauguration of the event took place in the gracious presence of Dr.R.P.Patange, Professor \& Head, dept. of Ob-Gyn. KIMS, Dr.Mrs.Sunita Tata, Director of Nursing Services, KH \& MRC, and Prof.Mrs.Vaishali R.Mohite, Principal, KJNS.

The welcome speech was given by Mrs. Vandana Satve
The subject expert Dr.Vijaya Krishnan was introduced to the august gathering by Mrs. Shectal Samson CP., Associate Professor, KINS, Karad .

Felicitation of Dr.Vijaya K. was done by Prof. Mrs.Vaishali R. Mohite, Dean, Faculty of Nursing Sciences, Karad


Dr. Vijay K Madam delivercd the introductory speech on the theme 'Gentle Birth' in which she highlighted the difference between a 'Normal delivery' and 'Gentle Birth' in today's obstetric practice. Dr. Krishnan displayed the current statistics of Cesarean sections in India which indicated a definite rise. She candidly explained how the various practices of routine interventions cause harmful interference in the birth -process and yet it is labeled a normal delivery. Articles showing the various measures adopted by different countries to deal with increased cesarean birth issue were put forth during the deliberation. Dr.Vijaya also explained the protocol for Humanized Birth which included following points:

- Nurturing Surrounding
- Upright Positions Preferable
- Emotional and Psychological Support
- Restriction in and judicious use of drugs
- Restriction in and judicious use of interventions such as I/V fluids, cpisiotomy, enema, forceps etc.

Mrs. Nitanjali Patil proposed a vote of thanks.

Morning session started at 10.30 am

## Session-I: GENTLE BIRTH: Facilitating a memorable birth-experience

- A paradigm shift from 'Delivery' to 'Birth' was explained with Natural birth, Gentle birth, Water birth, Delayed Cord Clamping/Lotus Birth. What natural birth means to the mother was explained by understanding the concept from mom's point of vicw i.e There needs to be no interference- No sound - Feeling that first contact is the mother's by rightNeed to reach for her baby and, instinctively, do what every uninterrupted mother since the beginning of time has done.
- Scientific midwifery care and a collaborative model was highlighted by disclosing its advantages of evidence-based practice that supports Scientific Midwifery as a key enabler of holistic, empathetic, safe and healthy pregnancy care, childbirth and postpartum care for childbearing women.
Outcomes that could be improved by care under the Midwifery Model :
-- Reduced maternal \& neonatal mortality \& morbidity
- Reduced stillbirth \& preterm birth
- Decrease in unnecessary interventions
- Reduced readmission rates for mothers and babies
- Improved psychological and public health outcomes
- Labour progress versus failure of labour to progress:

Labour progress increases oxytocin release making the mother feel sccure, want privacy. She wants peoples who she knows, and also she wants touch, comfortable environment, relaxation and encouragement. And if labour failure she feeling frightened.

- Lamaze Six Healthy Birth Practices discussed during the deliberation were:

1. Labor begins on its own
2. Freedom of movement throughout labor
3. Continuous labor support
4. No routine interventions
5. Non-supine (e.g. Upright or side-lying) positions for birth
6. No separation of mother and baby after birth

First session was highly informative and aroused interest among the participants. The session ended at 11.30 pm with a short stretch break.
12.00 PM - Session II started at 12.30 pm

This session focused on RECLAIMING NATURAL BIRTH

- Mother-Baby friendly care

Madam explained 10 steps of Mother Baby Friendly Care

- Step 1- Treat every woman with respect and dignity.
- Step 2-Possess and routinely apply midwifery knowledge and skills that optimize the normal physiology of birth and breastfeeding.
- Step 3- Inform the mother of the benefits of continuous support during labour and birth, and affirm her right to receive such support from companions of her choice.
- Step 4- Provide drug-free comfort and pain relief methods during labour, explaining their benefits for facilitating normal birth,
- Step 5- Provide evidence-based practices proven to be beneficial.
- Step 6- Avoid potentially harmful procedures and practices.
- Step 7-Implement measures that enhance wellness and prevent illness and emergencies.
- Step 8-Provide access to evidence-based skilled emergency treatment.
- Step 9-Provide a continuum of collaborative care with all relevant health care providers, institutions, and organizations.
Step 10- Strive to achieve the BFHI 10 Steps to Successful Breastfeeding
- Myths leading to a rise of C-sections- in that madam explain guidelines for prevention of the primary cesarean section
These are:
- Slow, but progressive labor in the first stage of labor should not be an indication for a C-section. As long as mother and baby are doing well, cervical dilation of 6 cm should be the threshold for active phase of labor.
- Only after 24 hours of induction with Pitocin/Syntocinon and ruptured membranes can induction be considercd as a failure!

This session closed at 1 pm
1 PM - THINK TANK and feedback from participant
During this session all participants were divided in groups with 10 participants per group. The groups were expected to provide 2 or more valuable suggestions for birth practice which can be applied in their current working setting. Participants had good and positive initiative and came up with numerous suggestions

Suggestions by the participants included:

1. Group I (Physiotherapy) :
-Relaxation therapy
-Body imagery and visualisation technique
2. Group II (MSc. Nursing students, INE Goa):
-Maintain privacy
-Avoid repeated PV cxamination
-Relaxation therapy
3. Group III (KH Staff nurses):
-Encourage mother for bear down
-Provide comfortable position

- Use positive statement

4. Group IV (4 ${ }^{\text {ti }}$ B. Bsc Nursing students, KINS, Karad):
-Choice for position
-Don't keep mother NBM

- Avoid perineum shaving

5. Group V ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ year RGNM Students, KINS, Karad):
-Allow family member with mother during labor
-Provide back massage to the mother
6. Group VI (4 ${ }^{\text {it }}$ B. Bse Nursing students, KINs,Karad):
-Calm and quiet environment for mother,

- Psychological support.

Rocking on all fours really helped take the pressure off on back. It may help the baby move down the birth canal.

- Using simple devices like rollers, acupressure equipments to clutch on, dupattas for Ribozo technique.
- Slow dancing technique
- Use of chair without arms for comfortable resting postion



## -Massage

Massage and counter pressure on back for effective pain relief.


In closing Dr.Krishnan played interesting videos of Lamaze birth and water birth.
The participants feedback revealed the fruitful experience of learning by doing that all that enjoyed during the seminar and the session closed at 5pm.

The entire session was an interactive one. A separate question time was allotted to clarify doubts of the participants.


## Summary:-

1] Fresh water management-
Raw water coming from rivers and bore wells is used for drinking and washing purpose in the campus. Raw water collected in the water storage tanks then passes through various chambers namely flash mixer, flocculation tank, tube settler, pressure sand filter-suspended solids \& turbidity is removed from water. Then it pass activated carbon filter for removing smell and color from the water. Then it pass to uv radiation to kill the bacteria then it pass through the softener remove the calcium \& magnesium in the water. And treated water is then store in treated water tank which is use for drinking purpose.

2] Waste water management-STP-
Sewage treatment plant is attached with the drainage water system capacity 500 KLD . It consists of bar screen chamber for removing floating material. Then water collected in Equalization tank its provide aeration assists in proper mixing of sewage with the help of air blowers. Then it pass through aeration tank \& then it pass to tube settler media the sludge settled at the bottom of the tank clean sewage enter into the chlorine contact tank. Then it pass through pressure sand filter for removing other remaining particals. Then it pass through activate carbon filter for removing color \& Odor present in the sewage. And enter the treated water tank. And then used for gardening.

3] Rain water harvesting-
The rain water from the terries of the building is brought to the rain water harvesting plant through 4" diameter pvc pipe line near rain water harvesting in the screen chamber to remove the floating materials \& then collect in rain water harvesting pit. ( 3 meter $\times 3$ meter $\times 3$ meter ) near bore to increase water level \& these water used for laundry \& gardening in summer season.
