Blood Bank is accredited by NABH. The Blood Bank of Krishna Hospital, Karad started functioning in 1984 as a part of pathology department and from 1995 it has become an independent department with separate qualified staff. Blood Bank Krishna Hospital has FDA approved lay out plan. Our blood bank has an area of 200.87 sq . meters. The area is distributed in three main sections, donor complex, laboratory area and component area.

The area of each section complies with the rule of Drug \& Cosmetic Act $1940 \&$ rules 1945. Under the scheme of modernization of blood banks, the Blood Bank was completely renovated in 2003 and blood components preparation was started in 2005. Now it is a fullfledged component blood bank.

Blood bank has got status of Regional Blood Transfusion Center in 2008. Krishna Hospital Blood Bank is recognized by Quality Council of India under National Accreditation Board for Hospitals \& Healthcare Providers (NABH) in June 2014. Blood Bank completed 3
years of Accreditation. Blood Bank successfully completed reaccreditation audit \& got renewal for the period 2017 to 2020.

Krishna Hospital Blood Bank is identified by Govt. of Maharashtra as training centre for blood bank Officer \& Technologist.

It is located in Karad (Maharashtra). It is working as nonprofit basis under charitable trust. It is well equipped and developed blood bank in this area. The major fields of activity include arrangement of voluntary blood donation camps, awareness lectures regarding blood donation.

36 Thalassemia patients are registered with us and they are provided blood and blood components free of cost whenever required. Also patients of heemophilia and other blood dyscresia receive blood \& blood components free of cost.

In modern healthcare, blood transfusion services plays vital role without which efficient medical care is impossible.

4. Identify the deviations from normal emotional process of birth
5. Demonstrate support measures in labour

## Brief Description of the Programme:

The Continuing nursing education program began with a short inaugural program. Dr. R.P. Patange, Prof. \& Head, Department of ob-Gyn, KIMS, inaugurated the program by lighting the lamp along with Mrs. Sheetal Samson, Assoc. Prof. \& Dean (Academics), KINS, Mrs. Alpana Sagare, Nursing Supervisor of Maternity Unit, Mrs. Helen Mahapure, Senior Nurse in-charge and representatives of nursing staff.

Dr. Patange addressed the gathering by affirming the importance of physiological approach to childbirth. He assured the nurses of his full support to optimize care towards normal childbirth for all low risk mothers. He also encouraged the nurses to learn the art and skills of labour support so that they can implement it in the labour room.

Mrs. Sheetal Samson thanked Dr. Patange for his hearty support and motivation rendered to the nurses. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Vishnupriya, I year M.Sc N. student and the compering was done by Ms. Reshma Kadam, II year M.Sc N. student of KINS.

In the first session Ms. Sheetal Samson spoke on the meaning of humanization of childbirth by drawing a parallel between the medical interventional approach and the physiological humane approach. All the findings put forth were well supported with good research from trusted update data base viz. Cochrane. The factors that promote the involvement of the mother and provide active participation of the mother which is very valuable to her intrinsic motivation to keep up with the physiological process of labour and childbirth were discussed in detail along with interesting power-point presentation and videos.

The second session covered the value of birth plan; the importance of active listening; reading the mother's emotional responses and gauging their state of mind for certain approaches and procedures. The aspect of birthing survivors of abuse was highlighted in the talk with examples. Poster and flash cards were used.

The third session touched the emotional deviations that cost the mother her wellbeing and deter her confidence to birth normally with further compromise on baby's wellbeing during the process and soon after birth. The nurse midwife's role in carrying out healthy birth practices was discussed with power point slides, relevant illustrations, role play and videos.

The hands-on session covered the demonstration of labour positions, massage techniques, breathing relaxation, use of birth ball, rebozos, hot and cold applications, lunges and squats. All the participants actively involved in return demonstration and expressed their satisfaction of learning new techniques for labour support.

Thus with post-test the CNE program concluded at 1.00 pm .

Types of spillage according to their volume
a) Major Spill = hazardous material, spills more than $30 \mathrm{grm} / 30 \mathrm{ml}$
b) Minor Spill = hazardous material, spills less than $30 \mathrm{grm} / 30 \mathrm{ml}$

Major Spill has to clean by biomedical waste management team and minor spill cleaned by class IV.

There are two types of spill kits
a) Hazmat Kit
b) Mercury Kit

During handling spillage has to follow following terms:
a) PPE usage before cleaning of hazmat spills.
b) Different procedure for different hazmat spills.
c) Use of appropriate spill kit for cleaning spill.

Disposal of collect hazmat spill as per BM waste Segregation.

To increase awareness of patients safety some general guidance and following patients safety stapes taken by hospital
a) Every starchier and wheelchair has Safety belt, so can patient does not fall during transfer.
b) Every patient bed has side railing
c) In the every toilet emergency bell \& installed
d) Infection control committee established.
e) Every staircase and ramp having side railings.
