1. Institution Deemed To Be University Status :

The Govt. of India on recommendation of UGC declared Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences as “Deemed to be University” vide its notification no. F.9-15/2001-U.3 of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India dt. 24th May 2005.

Vision :

To emerge as a centre of excellence following an interdisciplinary, innovative and quality centric approach that encompasses best evidence based higher education and generates refutative and translational research and offers affordable health care access for the benefit of mankind.

Mission :

KIMSDU shall prepare competent and compassionate professionals with sound knowledge and excellent skill through quality education based on a competency model that inculcates scientific temper, moral and ethical values. This mission has the following objectives.

Objectives :

- To foster interdisciplinary research that will generate meaningful outcomes for the community and nation.
- To provide quality health care to the rural and needy and bring about holistic development in the adjoining rural areas.
- To seek collaborations with national and international institutions of repute and provide a transparent and accountable governance system.

2. About Institution Deemed To Be University :

Krishna Charitable Trust, the sponsoring society of Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences “Deemed to be University” was established by philanthropist, social reformer and visionary late Shree Jaywantrao Bhosale.

He established the Institute with the objective of providing access to health care and education for people in rural areas.

The Krishna Hospital was started in 1982. In the year 1984 in terms of the vision postulated by the late Chief Minister of Maharashtra Shri Vasantao Dada Patil, the Govt. of Maharashtra in its resultant policy opened up the sector of professional education for

nonprofit organizations whereby the Govt. of Maharashtra vide GR no. MED/1684/952/Med4 dt. 3rd July 1984 permitted Krishna Charitable Trust to establish the Medical College as a maiden venture. Having fulfilled all the requirements of infrastructure, teaching faculty, equipments and facilities the MBBS degree was recognized by the MCI and the college was permitted to start post graduate courses in all relevant branches from 1991.

The changing frontiers of medical science and the advances witnessed in the growth of the health care sector and health education, the Institution applied to the Govt. of India for conferment of 'Deemed to be University' status.

The Govt. of India on recommendation of UGC declared Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences as "Deemed to be University" vide its notification no. F.9-15/2001-U.3 of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India dt. 24th May 2005.

After attaining the Deemed University status in May 2005 faculties of Dentistry, Nursing, Physiotherapy, and Pharmacy were started with the approval of the regulatory council's viz. Dental Council of India, Maharashtra Nursing Council, Indian Nursing Council, Indian Association of Physiotherapists, Physiotherapy council of Maharashtra and Pharmacy Council of India.

The Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences "Deemed to be University" continues with its vision, mission and objectives of meeting emerging challenges in health care by capacity building and producing knowledgeable, skilled and competent graduates to supplement the deficient manpower in the health sector. The Institution has always inspired its students in their pursuit for knowledge by providing a robust platform for research initiatives and innovations.

Several new postgraduate and doctoral programs have been introduced in addition to purpose oriented vocational courses, value added courses and fellowships in emerging, advanced and interdisciplinary areas.

As of now the Institute is the largest tertiary health care facility in southern Maharashtra with its multispecialty hospital having 1125 beds and state of art diagnostic and treatment facilities.

University is accredited by various accrediting agencies for its quality sustenance, enrichment and enhancement in academics and healthcare services.
