Following events were organized on this day:



Purpose: To screen the community people and to provide basic health care. Clinical examination for joint disorders, hypertension, obesity and diabetes.




Outcome: Peoples from village get clinically examined and treatment provided for basic elements.








Health Care Clinic

In this camp patients' general health checkup was done with all physical examination. Medicines were given to all patients and also given information about healthy diet and personal hygiene.






Guest Lecture

The above 2 adopted villages Khubi and Gondi are situated along the bank of Krishna River.

Khubi village is located in Karad taluka of Satara district in Maharashtra. It is situated 20 km's away from sub district head quarter Karad. The total geographical area of village is 233 hectares. Karad is nearest town to Khubi which is approximately 20 km's away. The Village has a Gram Panchayat, It is a medium size village with total 337 families residing. The village has population of 1690 of which 887 are males while 803 are females.

Background of Gondi:

Gondi is a Village in Karad Taluka in Satara District of Maharashtra State, India.

Gondi is located on the eastern bank of Krishna River. The total geographical area of village is 316.12 hectares. Gondi has a total population of 2,074 peoples. There are about 434 houses in Gondi village.

Karad is nearest town to Gondi which is approximately 17 km away.

Both these villages do not have a primary health center or sub center. They are chosen for adaptation by Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences "Deemed To Be University", Karad for serving the village community by organizing need based programs including various health programs with emphasis on cleanliness, Sanitation and preventive aspects of health care by awareness camps.

Work plan for Water Conservation and Management:

Assessment of water sources and availability:

There is abundant water supply in both the villages that are blessed with adequate rain fall as well as good ground water recharge attributed to river proximity.

Mapping and action plan :

Initially mapping exercise was undertaken in the village community to determine various needs, to create awareness about social issues like health and hygiene, sanitation, safe drinking water and development of civic infrastructure, through information about general layout of community, existing infra-structure facilities, presence or absence of water sources and status of availability of water.

Goal and objectives:

The goal of rural development program aims atimprovement in an equitable and sustainable manner both socially, environmentally through better access to facilities and services. Localuse

Formation of JalShaki team:

Each village constituted its JalShaki team comprising of 10 active members from the community, with the objective of creating awareness about sanitation, water conservation and management as well as sustainability of the project.

The team will focus on

- Availability of clean drinking water with R.O. system in place, its maintenance and repairs etc. and monitoring of water ATM.
- 2. Regular testing and reporting on water quality through government labs.
- 3. Plugging of water leakages.
- 4. Planning of tree plantation along the river banks and streets to avoid soil erosion.
- 5. Waste management of solid and liquid waste.
- 6. Recycling and diverting treated water if in excess for agricultural use's

Waste Management:

Solid Waste Management: Solid waste comes from kitchen waste i.e. food waste and other sources being toilets, drainage of gutters etc.

Proper management consists of:

- Conversion of food waste into manures.
 Each household is provided with covered bins with micro culture, and the people are taught to properly collect the garbage, ensure its mixing and compost production.
- 2. Toilet waste:

All the households have individual toilets with availability of water and soakage pit.

Both the villages are nearly 100% ODF (Open defecation free).

Our Students made house visits to demonstrate to villagers about hand wash technique and proper sewage disposal methods.

Gram Jal Shakti Abhiyan:

A Gram Jal Shakti team is established comprising of 10 members from each village. Both the Gram Panchayat's passed resolution to that effect, and assured to work for planning, co-ordination and implementation of proposed plan. The meeting was addressed by the experts in the field, ShashinKumbhojkar and SudhirKumhbar. Topics covered were cleaning of river Krishna (Namami Krishna).

The liquid waste from the village is getting discharged into the river and results in river contamination.

An elaborate plan for cleaning the river and avoiding contamination by liquid waste drain from the village was planned and executed as under and depicted in the schematic plan of drainage and waste water treatment at Khubi and Gondi.

The existing untreated liquid waste from drainage canal is diverted through -

- Screening chamber
- Filter chamber
- Soakage Pit
- Collection Tank

Thus the plant is used to divert untreated waste water, filtering it and then collecting the clean water in tank which is stored there and utilized for agriculture.







KIP Initiative: "Helping Hands for People Affected by Flood"

Activity Date: 11 and 12th August 2019

Due to heavy rain and flood situation in July and early August 2019, the major districts from Maharashtra State such as Sangli, Satara, and Kolhapur were suffering with tremendous loss. People had lost their hopes and almost everything in the flood.

Krishna Institute of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.), KIMSDU, Karad came forward to initiate the activity to help those people, and for this, **KIP Initiative:** "Helping Hands for People Affected by Flood" was planned by Krishna Institute of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.) under the guidance and support of Dean, Dr. R. C. Doijad, to help the flood victims and their families.

For this initiative, dean, all the staff members, and students from B. Pharm. donated voluntarily by their own. Around 18,500 Rs. were collected from the donations received. From that donation collected or received, students of KIP purchased and prepared the kits including different types of medicines, daily needed things, and the groceries.

Total 175 kits were prepared by the team on 11th August 2019 and distributed on 12th August 2019 in Sangli gramin area including flood affected villages namely, Amnapur, Vitthalwadi, Sheri, and Dhangaon.

The kits were distributed door to door by the team of students under the guidance of staff members Mr. Anup Patil, Dr. Rohit Bhosale, and Mr. Vishal Shah, along with the help of one non-teaching staff Mr. Sagar Karmalkar.
