QUALIFYING ROUND:

MEMORY GAME/ SEQUENCE RECALL: Participants will be shown a collage of images on the screen for 30-40 secs and then based on their ability to recall and remember information shown to them for a short period of time.

LEVEL - 1

TEAM GAME-

Team games encourage collaboration, communication, leadership, and problemsolving, all of which are essential aspects of college life.

- 1. PICTIONARY: A word-guessing game where players take turns drawing pictures to represent words for their teammates to guess. Time limit: 1 min. Winners will be decided based on how fast the team guesses the word.
- 2. JIGSAW PUZZLE: Teams will solve 3 Jigsaw puzzles at 3 separate checkpoints. Fastest ones to complete will enter the next.
- 3. REVERSE SCAVENGER HUNT: It flips the concept of a traditional scavenger hunt. Instead of hunting for pre-hidden items based on a list of clues, participants are tasked with finding or collecting specific items from their surroundings, people, or the venue itself.

LEVEL - 2

ACADEMICS

As academics reflect a student's intellectual abilities, critical thinking, problemsolving capabilities, mastery of knowledge, a level which consists of quizzes or riddles would be a great way to test these skills.

- 1. DECODE THE CIPHER: participants should decode ciphers such as scrambled words or sentences.
- 2. FACT OR FICTION: participants are presented with statements and must decide if they are true or false within seconds.
- 3. VISUAL TRIVIA: show participants close-up images of objects, landmarks, or logos, and ask them to identify what they are.

BONUS TIP: the rounds can be grouped into themed rounds like logic, memory, creativity, etc

LEVEL - 3

SPORTS/PHYSICAL CHALLENGES

As student of the year competition is based on all roundedness of students, sports tasks would be the ultimate challenge for them to win the SOTY title. This level can be divided into 2 rounds: sports based quiz and a physical task.

Tossing: Players will toss their stone into square one. If it lands incorrectly (outside the square or on the line), the player has to forfeit their turn.


Hopping: Players must hop through the squares, following the rules (balancing on one foot in single squares, both feet in side-by-side squares).






