- **International Women's Day:**



- **Breast Feeding week:**




- **Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons Day Celebration:**

- **World Oral Health Week:**






**Camp at Vidyanagar, Karad**




**Republic Day (26<sup>th</sup> January 2017)**






**Teachers Day (05<sup>th</sup> September 2016)**





### **Dental check up for school children**

- **Celebration of Oral Hygiene Day:**

Oral hygiene day is celebrated all across India on 1<sup>st</sup> August. As a part of the Oral Hygiene Day, School of Dental Sciences took the opportunity to spread awareness and importance of oral health in the community. The celebration began with free dental screening and treatment camp at Department of Periodontology. All the staff members and post graduate students from Department of Periodontology educated all the patients visiting to dental college about the importance of Oral hygiene maintenance with the help of audiovisual aids and demonstration on models. An Oral Hygiene Awareness Rally was also organized for creating awareness among the general population. The rally started at School of Dental Sciences followed by Oral Hygiene Awareness skit by group of students from 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> BDS near the entrance of Krishna Hospital. Pamphlets including tips for Oral Hygiene maintenance and toothpaste samples (sponsored by Colgate) were distributed among general population.

To create the awareness about Oral Hygiene among general public a street play was performed at Datta Chowk. At the end of the rally Oral hygiene awareness talk was given



with demonstration of oral hygiene methods using models.

All the gathered public applauded the efforts of students very well. A total of 162 students from 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> BDS and Interns participated enthusiastically in rally.

Department of Periodontology did not restrict the celebration to Oral Hygiene Awareness campaign alone, but also extended its services to save lives by organizing Blood donation camp in collaboration with Department of Oral Surgery and Blood Bank, Krishna hospital. Dance, games, antakshari and drawing competitions were arranged for children. Prizes were given to children and also gifts were distributed to all children. On this special occasion Dean Dr. Shashikiran N.D announced that those special 25 children have been adopted by Dept. of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry, School of Dental Sciences for their complete oral rehabilitation till the age of 18 years.

Around 250 children and villagers were screened and out of which 25 requiring dental attention were taken to School of Dental Sciences for the required treatment. Rest all were provided with health education, information on appropriate brushing technique and were provided with concessional treatment facilities.

- **World Cancer Day:**

'World Cancer Day' was celebrated by School of Dental Sciences on 04<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 by organizing a HEALTH EXHIBITION – CANCER under the theme of 'We can. I can'. This health exhibition aimed at spreading the awareness on risk factors of oral cancer, the modes of prevention of cancer along with information on the available treatment modalities. 

- **World No Tobacco Day:**







- **International Women's Day:**



**Wire bending competition**




- **Children’s Day Celebration:**

- **PROSTHODONTIC DAY:**



- **No Tobacco Day:**







with great impact. Later students performed bhajan singing in different languages. The programme concluded by singing the National anthem.




Rally was conducted in Karad city with the enthusiastic participation of the interns, students and the general public.


**The highlights of the screening camp were:**

5. Individuals who screened positive for oral lesions were *counseled for tobacco cessation* and were encouraged for subsequent *follow-up & for further treatment*.



**Distribution of Oral Premalignant Lesions Among the Screened Individuals (n= 75)**






the queries of the students regarding HIV transmission and risk was addressed by the staff of the department.



- **World Suicide Prevention Day:**




- **Celebration of National Sciences Day:**


- **Celebration of Teachers Day:**


towards teachers through WhatsApp individually and in group and on various social media like Facebook and Instagram.



- **Celebration Of World *Suicide Prevention Day***





- **Celebration of Birth Anniversary of Louis Pasteur:**



